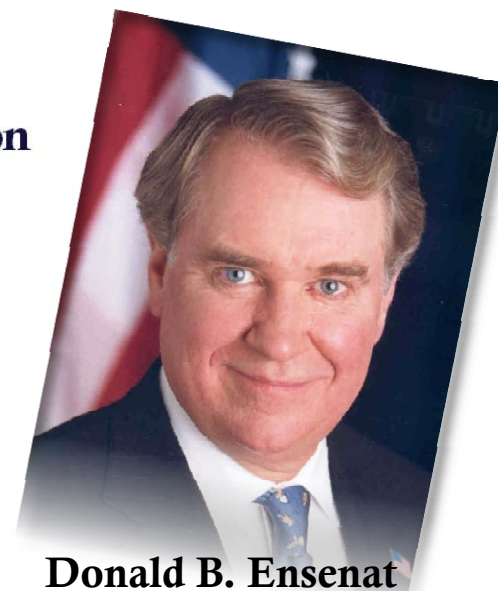

***Practice***

Mr. Ensenat began his international energy and maritime law practice in 1974. He has served in the government six times: as Legislative Assistant to Congressman Hale Boggs, 1974; Majority Whip and later Majority Leader of the U.S. House of Representatives; the first Legislative Assistant to Congresswoman Lindy Boggs, 1973-1974; Assistant Attorney General of Louisiana in charge of federal court and Louisiana Supreme Court litigation for the State of Louisiana, 1975-1980; President Bush appointed Mr. Ensenat, with Senate confirmation, to the Board of Directors of the Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC), 1989-1992; President Bush nominated and the Senate confirmed Mr. Ensenat as U.S. Ambassador to Brunei, 1992-1993; President Bush nominated and the Senate confirmed Mr. Ensenat as Chief of Protocol of the United States with rank of Ambassador, 2001-2007. Additionally, in 1970, he served as Former President George H.W. Bush's personal assistant during his campaign for U.S. Senator from Texas. He served in the U.S. Army Reserve from 1968-1974.
