His particular interest is the impact of Federal Law (i.e. Medicare, Medicaid, ERISA and personal income taxes) on personal injury and damage claims. Mr. Larue co-authored “Medicaid, ERISA and Other Medical Liens Against Personal Injury Recoveries,” which was published in the Louisiana Bar Journal. In connection with the 2003 Medicare amendments, he was featured in the National Law Journal. He is an adjunct professor at Tulane University Law School on negotiation and mediation advocacy skills. He was invited to and attended “The Master’s Forum” at Pepperdine University. Mr. Larue resides in New Orleans, LA and Cocoa, FL.
