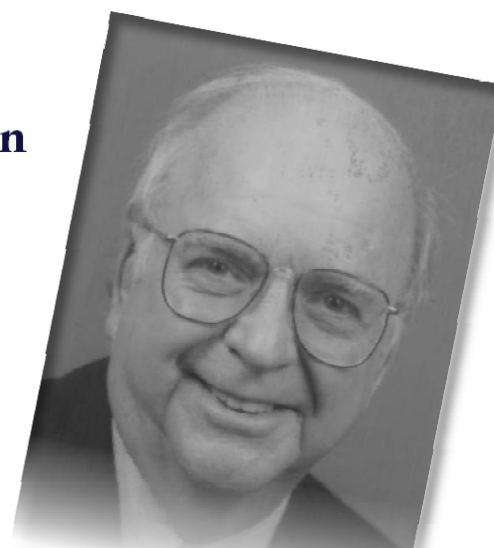

**Chief Justice Edwin  
Lloyd Pittman (Ret.)**  
*Mediator & Arbitrator  
Mississippi*

***Practice***

Edwin Lloyd Pittman retired from the Mississippi Supreme Court in 2004 after having served as a Justice since 1989, Presiding Justice from 1998-2001 and Chief Justice since 2001. His long career in public service included terms as State Senator, 1964-1972; State Treasurer, 1976-1980; Secretary of State, 1980-1984 and Attorney General, 1984-1988. He maintained a private law practice in Hattiesburg from 1960-1976. Chief Justice Pittman was a Commissioned Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army Infantry in 1957, and retired from the Mississippi National Guard in 1987 as a Brigadier General. His military experience also included the Judge Advocate General Corps. He is presently affiliated with the firm of PYLE, MILLS & DYE in Ridgeland.
